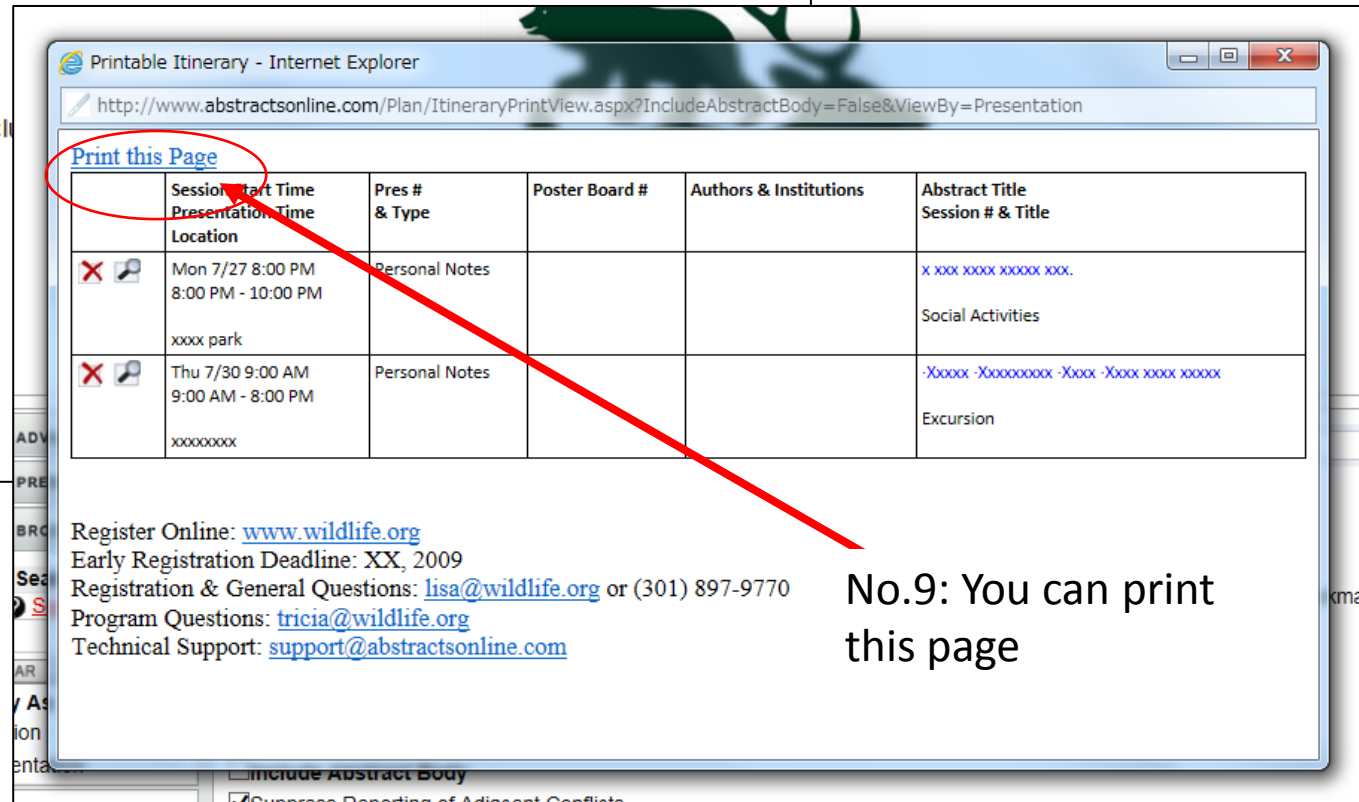


#### Program Planner Search Functions

The Online Program Planner's search functions allow you to produce focused session and presentation lists you can use to select items to add to your itinerary. The following search methods are available. Click the titles to jump to more detailed information and instructions.

<b>Boolean Search</b> The Boolean Search works like the search function you find on many Internet sites. You enter one or more keywords into a search box, and the Program Planner displays a list of results that match a term in the fields searched.	<b>Browse Search</b> The Browse Search offers several predefined browsing options, typically session type, session category, and date. These give you focused lists in which you can drill down to specific sessions and presentations.
<b>To perform Boolean Searches, use + before a word to include it, and a - before a word to exclude it. For example, if you typed:</b>  thermal +nociceptive -stimulated	<b>Advanced Search</b> The Advanced Search offers several predefined search fields (type, title, author name, date, etc.) that can help you rapidly locate specific presentations or groups of presentations that contain the search term in the fields.
